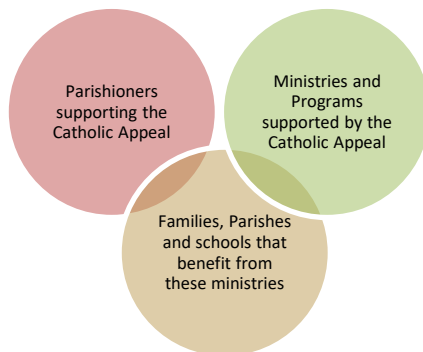

The Catholic Appeal by the numbers

256 parishes supported by Central Ministries

99 Catholic schools serving 31,000 students are supported by our Catholic Schools Office

3 Pregnancy Help Centers staffed by nurses and multilingual case workers

- 100+ pregnant and parenting women served each month

24 parishes have established palliative care resource groups

25 college and university campuses served by our Campus Ministry programs

28 hospitals across the Archdiocese are served by lay chaplains

13 prison chaplains serve in 23 prisons around Greater Boston

64 volunteer faith community nurses trained to work in parish communities

88 ethnic communities served

- 22 languages in which Masses are said each week

24 parishes with iThirst programs to train spiritual companions to accompany those in recovery

200 active deacons serving in parishes throughout the Archdiocese of Boston

500 catechetical leaders run parish faith formation efforts (religious education, youth ministry, RCIA, adult education, etc.).

- 90,000 children and youth are engaged in parish faith formation throughout the Archdiocese.

Did you know?

- 93 cents of every dollar raised goes directly to our ministries
- This year, 40 cents of every dollar raised over a parish's assessment will be returned to the parishes for their use. Over \$1.2M was returned to parishes as a rebate in 2022.
